How can interactive installations address the relationships between people in everyday liminal places and times?

Liminal place: a transitory space.

A space that is passed through between origin and destination.

(the arrow is the liminal place)

Liminal time: A period of transition.

The time between events.

(twilight is a liminal time)

Some everyday liminal places:

elevators staircases airports waiting rooms

Questions the changing space between two viewers and a vulnerable object in a gallery. It smashes porcelain spheres on the ground when viewers enter each other's intimate space and draw near to the piece.
